The second key focus area would be securing the Architect's professional fees for works they have already completed through LAM as stakeholder of the fees. I have been working in PAM for the last few years for this to be implemented. We are in the last few steps for this to be completed and I am committed to see it to completion. I believe Architects should be allowed to complete their professional responsibilities without having to worry about whether they will be paid for works they have completed. We will start with only housing projects where by the Architects Professional Fees will be transferred from the Housing Developer Accounts to LAM's stakeholder accounts. This is similar to the Registered Surveyors whose fees are paid to their board to ensure the completion of the property title. Architect's fee deposits would be to ensure that the CCC for the completed buildings is duly issues in a timely and efficient manner.

Thirdly, to promote the adoption of BIM by Malaysian Architects to give a quantum leap to their productivity. I believe that some of our clients have been appointing foreign and un-registered Architects because they have not seen the value that we as Architects are able to deliver because we have not been promoting ourselves very well and partly because some of these foreign architects have been able to deliver better value than some of us. I intend to initiate and to lead a change to this.

We have to first ask ourselves why our clients appoint us as Architects. One of key duties is to prepare integrated and coordinated drawings quickly and accurately. This is the areas of our service that we can make significant improvements through the adoption of BIM or Building Information Modeling. BIM is going to be an important future tool for Architects to compete both locally and internationally. Under this effort to up-skill Malaysian Architects, I have been working with PAM to secure PEMANDU's funding for programs of awareness and training for BIM in 2012. In 2013-2014 this program will be expanded to secure funding assistance for BIM hardware and software acquisition and training for all Architects. This is to put Malaysian architects on equal footing with foreign architects who have been receiving these types of assistance from their governments.

There are several other initiatives which were started by the previous PAM council which I see as important to follow through. These include:

Up-skilling the Graduate Architects to Professional Architects is the other area of focus. In the last Part 3 LAM examination, less than 10 percent of the candidates passed. This is a reflection of the weakness in our Graduate Architects in Professional Practice. We need to urgently address this. This can only be done by intensifying the effort to improve the knowledge and skills of these graduates and certainly not by compromising standards. Specific Professional Practice programs have already been initiated by PAM every weekend and more will be done. I also intend to initiate a Mentoring Program for these graduate Architects to accelerate their learning.

Getting the Architectural Graduates from un-recognized Universities to get their registrations with LAM. This effort is intensified by identifying these graduates and assisting them to get their registrations through provisions already exist under the Architect's Act 1967, such as the portfolio and design examinations.

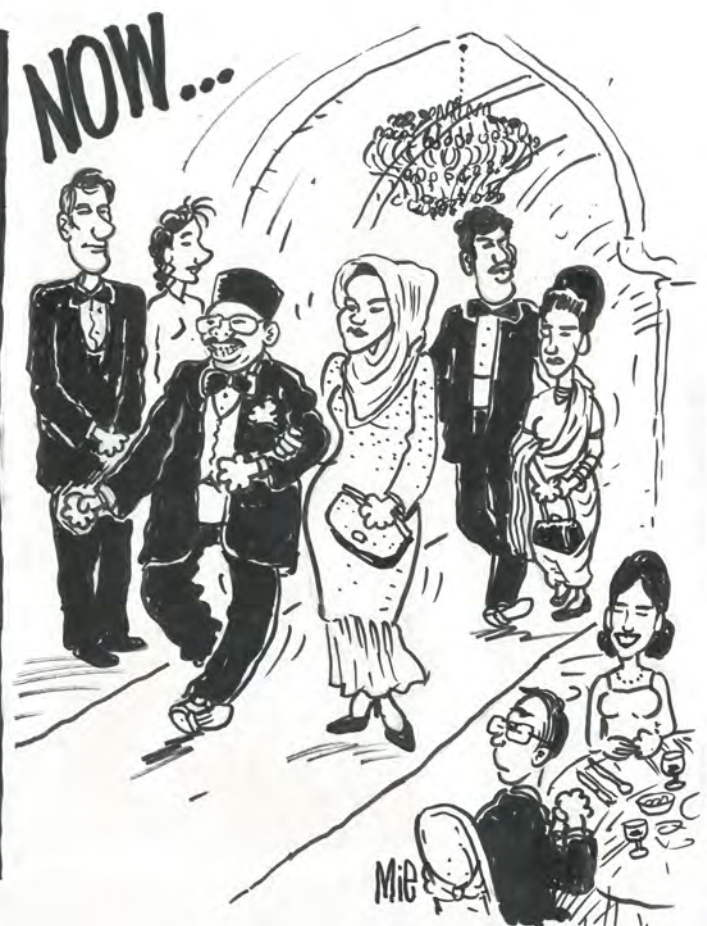
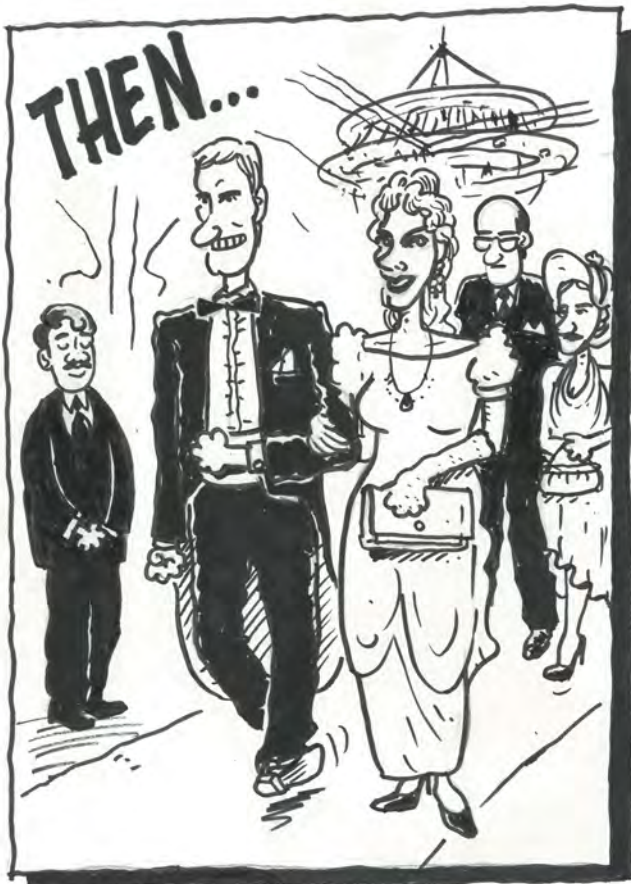
Finally, the most important skill of the Architect – DESIGN will continue to get my attention. We will continue with our efforts to have key national projects offered for open competitions to give opportunities to all members to get recognition for their best works.

Expanding the DATUM and Archidex showcase. These annual PAM events have been hugely successful in showcasing Malaysian Architects' works and exposing our Architects to emerging Architecture in other parts of the world. I will continue to expand and grow these programs.

Fellow PAM members, I hope you will step forward to join the many committees in PAM to work with our council members in this coming year. I give my commitment to lead and serve you in PAM.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF THE MINUTES OF THE FIRST MEETING OF PAM COUNCIL 2013-2014 HELD ON 16 MAY 2013

Update on the Development of the New PAM Centre at Jalan Tanduk - The drawings for the amendments are ready for submission. Ar. Saifuddin Ahmad and Ar. Chan Seong Aun will oversee together for the completion of the new PAM Centre.

Proposal by LAM to abolish automatic recognition of overseas' architecture programmes - Council was reminded that the previous Council had made a stand that PAM does not support the abolishment of automatic recognition of overseas architecture programmes and this will be reiterated at the next LAM Board Meeting.

Graduates from unrecognised programmes - PAM had submitted a proposal for the waiver of Part I and Part II exemption examination however the LAM Board had disagreed with the explanation that there is already a mechanism established at LAM to address the issue. PAM will continue to pursue the proposal for the waiver of the Part I and Part II proposal. The Education Committee will look into identifying the names and numbers of graduates from unrecognised programmes who are willing to register with LAM, and organise an integrated programme for this group of people to be registered with LAM.

Council deliberated on whether to consider projects of collaboration between foreign and local architects for future PAM Awards and agreed to consider having a separate category for projects which have collaborations.. The Awards, Competitions and Events (ACE) Committee will submit to Council a proposal for the PAM Awards 2014 with consideration of the above-mentioned issue.
