Kuala Lumpur Architecture Festival 2011

Since 2003, the Datum:KL conferences have become the anchor event in the architects' calendar. With 2011 being its 9th year, PAM has this year decided to embark on a more ambitious and expansive programme.

Datum:KL will now be planned as a month-long multi-programme celebration of architecture and the city of Kuala Lumpur, to be known formally as **Datum:KL, the Kuala Lumpur Architecture Festival**. Organised by PAM, the Festival is conceived as a month-long multi programme event to be held throughout July 2011. Modelled along the lines of international events such as the Venice Biennale and the London Architecture Festival, the Festival aims to bring forth wider, cultural aspects of the discipline onto the public domain and to invigorate the city of Kuala Lumpur into new and purposeful dialogues. PAM's objective is also to establish Datum:KL to be the key definitive regional architecture and design event.

As this will be our inaugural year, we have planned for several major exhibitions to run in conjunction with the regular two-day International Architectural Design Conference, rebranded as the NOW conference and ARCHIDEX. A series of workshops, forums and special events will also be organised throughout the festival month. We are now in the planning stages and we will be issuing a more detailed programme soon.

We call on our members for your support and participation to make the Festival a successful one. We envisage Datum:KL to be a platform and opportunity for members to showcase their talents and initiatives to a wider public audience, and for architects to build a sustaining, energetic and positive engagement with Kuala Lumpur in the public domain. Thus, we seek and welcome your participation and ideas for any suggestions or projects that you may have to make the 2011 Festival the starting point from which we chart new territories and possibilities.

Executive Summary of the Minutes of the Sixth Meeting of PAM Council 2010 – 2011

25 February 2011_PAM Centre, Kuala Lumpur

Council unanimously approved the **membership applications** for 3 Fellow Memberships, 10 Corporate Memberships, 14 Graduate Memberships, 1 Associate Graduate Membership, 1 Student Membership, 2 Reinstatements of Corporate Membership, 2 Reinstatements of Graduate Membership, and 32 Ordinary Memberships above 65 years old.

The **Southern Chapter** proposed to host the Council Meeting in Johor Bahru on 20 May, subject to confirmation from the Menteri Besar of Johor, as he has been invited as the Guest Honor to the Annual Dinner which coincides with the Council Meeting.

The Chief Minister of Sarawak, Pehin Sri Haji Abdul Taib Mahmud, has accepted invitation as the Guest of Honour for the **Building Trade Show** on 24 March 2011, in Kuching, Sarawak.

Council agreed for the **Education Committee** to continue to run the Travel Scholarship for students.

The Convention Committee is requested to allocate a bigger space for the ARCHIDEXII Students Exhibition as the Committee plans to invite students to submit projects based on the Convention theme. The Education Committee will prepare a more detailed proposal on the exhibition for consideration, and would also invite University Academicians to submit for the exhibition instead of just students' works.

The **GBI Tools** are planned to be launched as follows:

- i. GBI Township Tool: end March 2011
- ii. NRNC Industrialised Building and Data Centre: end April 2011
- iii. NRNC Mall: May 2011
- iv. NRNC Hotel: June 2011
- v. NRNC Public Health and NRNC Version 2: July 2011

Executive Summary of the Minutes of the Seventh Meeting of PAM Council 2010 – 2011

18 March 2011_PAM Centre, Kuala Lumpur

Council unanimously approved the **membership applications** for 6 Corporate Memberships, 14 Graduate Memberships, 24 Student Memberships, 2 Reinstatements of Corporate Membership, 2 Reinstatements of Graduate Memberships, and 4 Ordinary Memberships above 65 years old.

Council extended congratulations to Puan Maimunah binti Mohd. Sharif who has been appointed as **Yang Dipertua Majlis Perbandaran Seberang Perai (MPSP)**.

Ar. Yong Ming Cheong (Past Chapter Chairman/IPEX 2011 Organising Chairman) led seven members including Deputy Chapter Chairman Ar. Lo Su Yin for a **courtesy visit to the Sabah Ministry of Industrial Development** on 1 March 2011. The agenda of the courtesy visit included briefing on GBI, offer of professional expertise to the Ministry of Development, and extending invitation as Guest of Honour of IPEX.

The **Architecture Education Roundtable** was successfully held on 26 and 27 February 2011 in Air Keroh, Malacca. The draft White Paper on the outcome of the Roundtable has been circulated to all participants

for comments. Council unanimously endorsed to establish the PAM Graduate School, and subject to comments from participants, to forward the White Paper on Architecture Education to the relevant Government departments and present a preferred proposed model of the architecture course to the Minister of Higher Education.

The **launch of the GBI Township Tool and RNC (Version 2)** Tool by the Minister of Housing and Local Government, Dato' Wira Chor Chee Heung, would be held on 29 March 2011.

Council agreed to nominate Goh Ching Chia (Singapore) as President, Dato' Sri Ar. Haji Esa Mohamed as Vice President Region IV and Dr. Chalay Kunawang (Thailand) as Council Member Region IV, as **candidatures of the UIA Bureau and Council for term 2011-2014**.

Council endorsed the proposal to nominate Ar Tan Pei Ing, and Ar Tan Pei Ing agreed to vie for **President of ARCASIA for term 2012 – 2013**.

Council was briefed on some of the recommendations affecting architects made at the **PEMANDU LAB on 'Liberalisation'**.

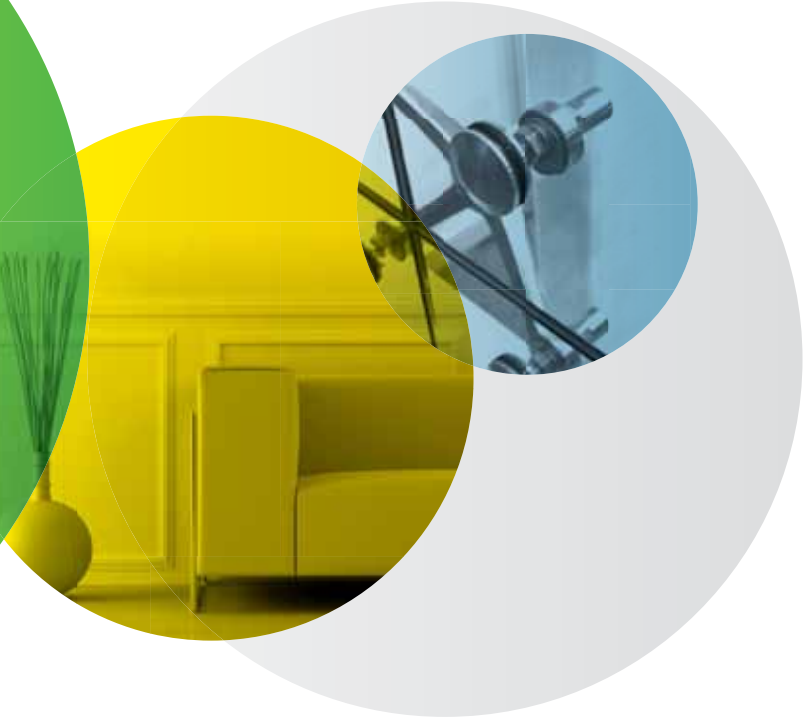
